Notification

In continuation to the **Guidelines Relating to Conduct and Evaluation of Examinations for Programme of LLB Degree Three Years (Annual Scheme) for Affiliated Colleges for the Session 2020-21** issued on 17-12-2021, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor is pleased to approve following partial amendments in the Guidelines.

The present provisions of the Guidelines are as below:

Para (b) of II- Examination and Evaluation of GUIDELINES RELATING TO CONDUCT AND EVALUATION OF EXAMINATIONS FOR PROGRAMME OF LLB DEGREE THREE YEARS (ANNUAL SCHEME) FOR AFFILIATED COLLEGES FOR THE SESSION 2020-21

“A candidate who fails in any year during the Three Year LLB Course shall be eligible for promotion to either LLB Second Year or Third Year subject to that he/she has secured 36% marks in individual paper and 48% marks in aggregate at least in six papers out of nine papers shall only be promoted in the next higher class.”

The amended provisions of the Guidelines are as below:

Para (b) of II- Examination and Evaluation of GUIDELINES RELATING TO CONDUCT AND EVALUATION OF EXAMINATIONS FOR PROGRAMME OF LLB DEGREE THREE YEARS (ANNUAL SCHEME) FOR AFFILIATED COLLEGES FOR THE SESSION 2020-21 as follows: -

a. “A candidate who fails in LLB First Year of the Three Year LLB Course shall be eligible for promotion to LLB Second Year subject to that he/she has secured 36% marks in individual paper and **45% marks in aggregate at least in six papers** out of nine papers shall only be promoted in the next higher class.”

However, for Pass, the aggregate marks required shall remain 48% in each respective class.

b. Regarding Grace Marks for Pass, it is resolved that 1% (one percent) marks of the maximum marks of appeared subjects/papers by the examinee, shall be awarded to him/her subject to division in the maximum of two subject/papers.

c. Further, such Grace Marks shall only be awarded to the candidate **either** in individual subject/paper as mentioned above **or** in 48% i.e., aggregate marks to Pass the examination of that class.

Note: - The above amendments shall only be applicable for the LLB First Year Examination of 2020-21. The result of LL. B First year Examination 2020-21 declared on 13-04-2022 shall accordingly be revised.
